December 1973

On December 28, 1973, about forty persons interested in genealogy met in Perini Science Building at St. Anselm's College in Manchester, N.H. The meeting chairman was Prof Roger W. Lawrence who with Mrs Lucille Lagasse had formulated plans for a society of Canadian ancestry genealogists. To open the meeting, Prof. Lawrence outlined the purposes and plans of the society. The plans include a quarterly periodical, instructional workshops, a library of reference materials, and a card file of marriages of persons of Canadian ancestry. A major purpose of the society is to serve as a resource of information linking the genealogies of the United States and Canada. In addition, we hope to establish a liaison between our members and those of Canadian genealogical societies.

Mrs. Lucille Lagasse spoke about the interest shown in the formation of this society and the response by an inpouring of mail containing many memberships and statements of encouragement. She encouraged the work of genealogy which brings us to closer intimacy with our ancestors and especially the personal bits of history that research reveals of a special nature to each genealogist.

A proposed constitution presented for consideration was discussed by the assembly. Minor alterations were made and the amended constitution was accepted with the contingency that the future executive board review it further.

Plans to meet biannually were accepted with the spring meeting solely for genealogical topics and the fall meeting to include a business session with elections. Recess for refreshments followed allowing members to become acquainted. Upon resumption of business, a slate of officers was proposed and nominations accepted for three directors. A voice vote unanimously elected the nominees for the ensuing year as follows:

The seven elected persons constitute the Executive Board.

On October 26 1973, the Executive Board met in Manchester, N.H. at the home of Mr. & Mrs. Lagasse. Mr. Bisailon reported an excellent response to a questionnaire mailed to members requesting a listing of their interests and reference library. Cooperative and mutual use of these references is available to members. A compilation of the references and locations will be sent to each member. It was reported that vital records not previously available and indexed at the Manchester, N.H. City Hall will become available in the near future. With the aid of members of our society and of other genealogical groups in N.H. indexing will begin this month.

Workshops supervised by members are planned for next year in Manchester and other cities to advise workers and newcomers in genealogical research. The workshops will be held as needed, some regularly, others occasionally.

It was agreed that the designation of charted member be given to any person joining the society during 1973 with membership to extend through 1974.

Expenses were discussed and it was agreed that \$2.00 membership fee seems adequate to finance the proposed activities for the coming year. Of major interest was the decision to publish a quarterly journal. The initial issues would be modest in size, but would be in a format suitable to be used for subsequent and more substantial issues. The journal will cover current activities, research information, and genealogical articles by members and other contributors. The editor of the journal is Mr. Henri Chapdelaine, the corresponding secretary. (Mr. Chapdelaine found it necessary to resign from both these positions and Mr. Leo Bisailon has taken the editorship).
