We agreed to reimburse Mrs. Janet Jehn the amount of \$200.00 for her trip to our semi-annual meeting.

We also agreed to offer \$25.00 to Professor Robert G. Leblanc who will address our conference in October.

The Hooksett Woman's Club sent a \$25.00 donation to the Society in appreciation of Dick Fortin's presentation.

Dick Fortin will contact Mr. Lemieux at A.C.A. to ask about a loan of their genealogical materials.
