- F Membership: Helen Tuttle reports that we have received dues for 42 renewals, 6 new, 3 family and 3

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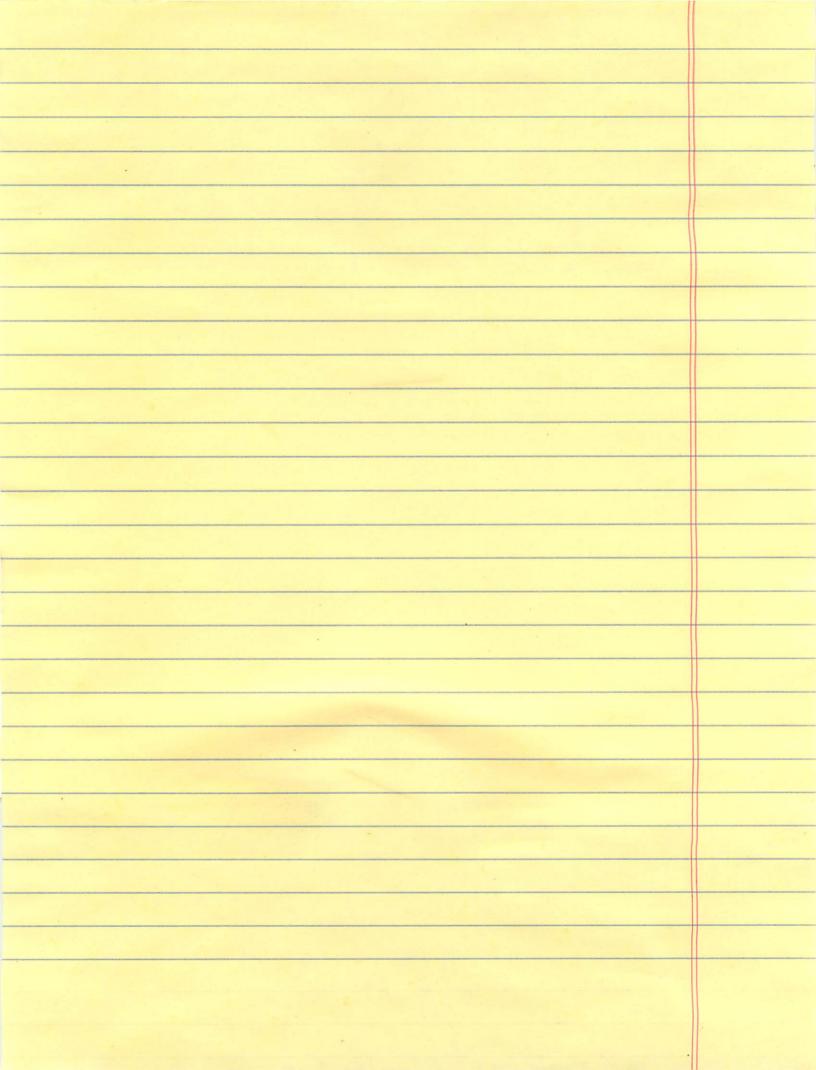
All requests to loan books from the library must receive prior approval of either the Chariman of the Library Board or the President. Repertoires may not be loaned out to individuals.
