Inventory of each cabinet is complete except the Acadian section. This makes it easier to know what # we are up to in each county and make a quick check of books.

B Library Treasurer: Roger Lawrence reports that he has on order about 20 repertoires and that books are still coming in.

C Editorial Board: Anne Marie Bradley announced the Genealogist is at the printer and this should be out by the 21st. As far as inserts we are staying with what was mentioned last month except that as of now we still do not have a Pres. letter.

As far as the Conference, we only have one definite speaker and we could really use help in putting this together.

Our permit to the Manchester P.O. was rejected due to lack of sufficient data submitted. It looks like we will have to remain at the Goffstown P.O. for one more year.

D Publication: Nothing new to report.

E Research Dept.: Louis Valliere reports that shortly after the last meeting he presented Helen with a check to purchase the Loiselles tapes. We are still waiting for a date when pick up on these is possible.

F Membership: Renewals still coming in steady. The Genealogical Pub. Co. request our membership list. This list is not for sale or given away gratis. A notice could be placed saying the Co. is willing to mail a copy of their Spring catalog to members requesting one.

G Computer: Al Hamel reports he has received input about the Maine Speaker on Computer and this is still a possibility for our conference. This should be scheduled along with something else so as to give people an alternative choice.

Data entry people are needed to input materials. Home computer input is almost a necessity but the computers must be compatible to ours. The survey might turn up some help in this field.

H Maine Chapter: Their meeting has been changed to the same night as ours and seeing that they meet only quarterly, Paul Boucher excused himself to make himself available to attend theirs

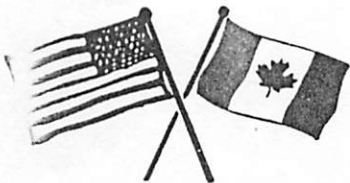


