

ACGS
MEETING OF BOARD OF DIRECTORS
19 JANUARY 1995

CALL TO ORDER A regular meeting of the Board of Directors was held on Thursday 19 January 1995 at the ACGS library. President Roger Lawrence called the meeting to order at 18:42.

ROLL CALL Diane Lavoie was absent. Leo Morency is no longer a member of the Board. A quorum was present. Also in attendance was Ray Desfosses.

RECORDING
SECRETARY The minutes of the 08 December 1994 meeting were reviewed. Several corrections were offered. There was some discussion as to whether the meeting notes should be continued in narrative form or changed to an outline format. Anne-Marie offered to draw up the December notes as an example. There seemed to be general sentiment that the notes could be more brief. There was a suggestion that the audio tapes could substitute for much of the notes; however, it was pointed out that they are routinely overwritten after one year. **Gerry Nash moved** to accept the notes for filing; **Anne-Marie Perrault seconded**; motion carried - notes will be filed as corrected.

TREASURER'S
REPORT Brenda Costello noted that she still had some checks from December which had yet to be deposited. She received bills from the gas company for the past two months - for \$900 and \$1,300. There was some discussion as to possibly saving money by keeping the thermostat low on the upper floor; Ray Desfosses said it was kept at 55° F. Bob Maurier inquired as to the advisability of purchasing a timer for the thermostat(s). Pauline Cusson asked if we could have someone from the gas company come in to see if we were operating the system as efficiently as possible. Discussion turned briefly to the idea of having a tenant to share expenses. Brenda noted that the electric bills were relatively constant.

Roland Marchand asked about the status of pledges. Brenda noted that, of \$67,560 pledged, \$23,268 was still due. [\$44,292 rec'd.] She did receive a check for \$2,500 from a Norma Perry. This led to a discussion concerning acknowledgment of gifts. Judy Arseneault will check with Julie Smith on the list of contributors and acknowledgments.

Roger Lawrence noted that there was insufficient ready cash to pay anything on the building debt this month. He then directed that the treasurer's report be filed for audit.

Pauline Côté asked how our audit was progressing. Brenda replied that the auditor had all the information he needed for '93.

Pauline Cusson asked where the entry for the transfer of funds to the Maine (Fr Leo Begin) chapter could be found. She noted that we return about 40% of what we collect in dues from those members to that chapter for maintenance of their library. Brenda agreed that we need an entry to reflect this expense. Gerry Nash asked if that chapter had anything unique and, if so could we get copies. Most thought that there was not anything that was so. Roland asked if we could request from them a list of their holdings. Anne-Marie noted that we do receive copies of their meeting minutes and of their newsletter.

PRESIDENT'S REPORT

Roger Lawrence read the letter of resignation from Leo Morency. He asked Lucille Lagassé if she would consent to take back the publicity duties. Lucille agreed. Roger then asked if there may be anyone else interested in serving on the Board. Pauline Côté will ask a Don Chaput.

Purchase from Advanced Circuit Technology: chairs were \$27.50 each; we also got 2 clothes racks, several wastebaskets, and some shelving.

Parishes lined up to be copied: Fr Croteau of Holy Rosary in Hooksett asked about our policy concerning (suspected) illegitimacies. Roger told him that we did not include these. Lucille asked if we could place a message at the beginning of each repertoire so stating; consensus was that we should. Fr Leo Leblanc of St Joseph's in Nashua said OK, as did the pastor at Ste Therèse in Manchester.

Roger recently spoke to Bob Gaudet; Bob is about to agree that we will own his records when he dies.

Concerning the ACA furniture, Roger did not have enough help to move (most of) it.

Roger asked Ovide Lamontagne about (Manchester) city directories. Could the ACA's collection be stored in our library? Roger also asked if we could devote the alcove in the east end of the library to city directories. Bob Maurier said he has quite a collection of these but had been reluctant to place them here until a suitable space had been designated. Most agreed to use this location; method of shelving was discussed without resolution.

Roger then presented a list of proposed projects for the Society for study by the Board. (They are attached to these notes.) He felt that it would give us some direction.

We will have to reprint the tri-folds soon. There was some discussion about printing them in color. The idea appeared to be too expensive and was not acted upon.

A Doug Gove was suggested as a coördinator to make a videotape of the library. Roger asked if we might consider renting out, perhaps the first floor, for reunions and the like. Lucille remarked that it would not generate as much revenue as would a more permanent tenant, but that it would be, at least, some income.

There was considerable discussion concerning PC's for the library — how many, what kind, what peripherals, etc. No resolution on this.

VICE PRESIDENT'S REPORT

Pauline Cusson reported on the Spring Conference. Notwithstanding upcoming construction at Perini Hall at St Anselm, it will be available for the Fall meeting. Janet Scheidler, assistant professor of French at Potsdam College in New York has agreed to speak on Franco-Americans from Tupper Lake to Chateaugay, plus another presentation. She's willing to do it for per diem and lodging and will pay for her own transportation. Dick Fortin had suggested someone from Louisbourg or from the Québec archives. Neil Boucher's name was also mentioned.

Pauline also received a call from Jan Burkhart (the Pawtucket society) concerning the purchase of microfilm reels of Maine vital records. She also wished to know where to purchase Loiselle supplements. Pauline noted that Massachusetts microfilms are for sale.

COMMITTEE REPORTS

Library: Roger said that a Ms Collette had been entering updates to some repertoires. Bob Maurier asked if Connie Hamel had yet shifted many of the head librarian's duties to Diane Lavoie. Roger said no. There was much discussion as to getting a replacement trained for Connie by 01 Mar.

Acquisitions: Bob Maurier reported on the "blue" Drouin — the hold up is still the 1,049 pages which need replacement. We'll need shelves to store them properly and have 3 potential builders. **Anne-Marie moved** that we padlock the closet with the Drouins, so that they would be used by researchers only. (No second.)

Research/Publications: (Pauline Côté) St Edmond repertoires in error are not to be sold; new ones will go to printer soon. Infant Jesus is now in copying stage and almost done. Starting St Joseph's in Laconia. Roland Marchand asked what we should do with the extra set of photocopies we get when we do data entry. Pauline Cusson suggested that we do an inventory to see what we have. Do we need a shredder to dispose of these? The PC's we have from Belanger seem not to be of much use to us as he did not want us to load any of our software. Roger will speak with him about having unrestricted use of one, or both, of his PC's.

Computer: Nothing more to report than what was discussed above.

Grants: Anne-Marie distributed copies of her progress report. NYNEX wants a long range budget. There were several suggestions from the Board for answering some of the 30 points to be addressed in the grant proposal. Brenda to get some financial data to Anne-Marie within 7-10 days.

Lafayette Press only printed (or New Hampshire Mailing only sent out) 2,300 copies of the Genealogist instead of the usual 2,400. Anne-Marie feels that there are at least 50 missing; she can only account for 2,241 copies. Gerry suggested that the next issue contain a reminder about the fund drive.

Building: Ray Desfosses reported that we now have our occupancy permit. We were billed \$174 for the last snow storm. He has been taking "parts" from the 1st and 3rd floors to fix the 2nd; if we rent, we'll have to replace. Still has the problem of insufficient air in the boiler. Brenda said she had a bill from a Rick Briand for fixing the kitchen sink — should it be billed to the building fund? Yes, it was needed to get the occupancy permit.

Publicity: In Leo's absence, Roger reported of the breaking of the globe in the fir alarm box outside.

BUSINESS**

Roger expressed a need to have a committee to study getting business contacts. Anne-Marie suggested joining the Chamber of Commerce and having meetings here.

What do we do with the viewers from Ray St Marie? Pauline Cusson suggested sending him a letter of acknowledgment — but no payment or lifetime membership.

Roger to answer letter concerning hired staff.


Jack Stanton to draw up by-laws amendment to add Building Committee.

PROGRESS REPORT ON WRITING OF GRANT PROPOSALS

To Board of Directors
From Anne-Marie P.
Date: 12 JAN 1995

I. Two proposals have been written and sent. These include the Penates Foundation and the Stable Family Foundation. These seemed to be the easiest and shortest. I've set a goal of one a week. The next proposals will be increasingly more complicated and demanding.

II. Next Grant Proposal: NYNEX Foundation.

Nynex makes contributions and grants in the areas of education, arts, culture, community service, health and human services. In 1993, in New Hampshire, Nynex funded the following (a sampling): Currier, \$50,000; Federated Arts of Manchester, \$12,500; Nashua Symphony, \$2000; Souhegan Theatre Council, \$2000; Child Health Services, \$2500; French Hill Neighborhood/Nashua, \$7500; Manchester Crimeline, \$1000; Antioch University, \$1300; UNH, \$20,000; Arthritis Foundation, \$1000; Easter Seal, \$11,000; Salvation Army, \$1000; YMCA, \$7500.

Criteria for eligibility

10. What action is proposed
11. How action will be carried out
12. What results are expected
13. How results will satisfy community needs
14. Time frames for project
15. Budget for project
16. Qualifications of person who will be responsible for project.
17. Anticipated cooperation with other community organizations
18. Proposed method of accountability should funding be granted.
19. Information on other sources of support
20. Well-planned funding strategy, showing need for the contributions without dependence on any single source of assistance.
21. Evidence that organization is accountable for its actions with regular self evaluation and public reporting
22. Evidence that organization fosters development of skilled leadership.
23. Copy of 501 (c) (3).
24. Copy of tax form 990
25. Copy of yearly budget and audited statements for last two years
26. List of Directors and officers
27. Evidence of competent leadership
28. Evidence of active participation by board
29. Evidence of effective use of volunteers
30. List of current contributors and amounts.

I am writing you to request a grant in the amount of \$4015.00 for the purchase of Xinerdy Pentium-P90 personal computer (please see attached quote from Xinerdy Microsystems). This would be used in furthering our goals, specifically to establish a unique data base of Franco-American marriages .

The American-Canadian Genealogical Society (ACGS) was founded at Manchester, New Hampshire in September 1973 by Professor Roger W. Lawrence and Lucille Caron-Lagassé, and serves people interested in ancestral research and family history. Although we are centered in New Hampshire, ACGS includes members from all of the 50 United States, all Canadian provinces and many *francophone* countries around the world.

The chief aim of the Society is to serve as a resource center for the gathering, preservation and dissemination of Franco-American and French-Canadian genealogical information. ACGS is a non-profit, tax-exempt 501 (c) (3) organization, registered with the Secretary of State of New Hampshire.

The gathering of genealogical information involves working with church repertories, genealogies, notarial records, indices, histories, biographies, journals, censuses and vital records at every level of municipality. We encourage individual members to research their family lineage and to contribute their work to our library. We also encourage the gathering of any and all civil and church records for publication and genealogical research. Added to these records and repertories are personal and public data such as is found in bibles, newspapers, directories, histories and photographs.

It has become almost impossible to gather and archive this material without a computer. ACGS owns a COMPAQ IT (8086) with only 520 RAM. The machine is almost 10 years old, can not be upgraded, and only minimally meets our needs to track membership. All other work is "farmed out" to our members who have their own personal computers. Our repertories of church records which we have published in the last few years have all been printed on laser printers in members' homes on their own equipment.

In order to consolidate the publication of our repertories in one location, and to serve not only our members but the general public, we need to purchase a computer such as is described on the attached quote from Xinerdy Microsystems.

Many genealogical records are now available on Compact Disk and this medium is almost obligatory for libraries such as ours. The 600 DPI printer produces Stat Camera ready material, thereby avoiding the expense of professional typesetting and pagination. The flat-bed, full-page scanner relieves volunteers of the tedium of thousands of hours of data-entry.

When we spoke with Sherri in your office, we were told to keep our letter of request as simple as possible. I have tried to do that, but would be most pleased to provide more information. I can be reached at my home office at (603) 622-1591, or by fax at (603) 626-9812.
