Computer Committee Report

This is the Report from the Computer Committee for the meeting on July 13, 2000. I have been very busy so I don't have a lot to report. The following things have been done in the past few months, or need to be done in the near future.

- 1) Replaced the monitor on one of the computers that appeared to be defective. It appears there is something wrong internal to the monitor, and Roland or I will be looking at it in the near future to see if it is repairable.
- 2) To go along with #1, we would like to request permission to purchase a couple of used or new monitors to hold in reserve, in case something like #1 happens again. We do not have very many monitors that are of good quality at this time.
- 3) We replaced the LDS computer with a computer which would be better for running LDS on (i.e. smaller hard drive, less RAM) The old LDS computer was not a very efficient use of our resources at the library. We also only loaded the LDS computer with DOS only, which makes running the LDS programs much simpler than with Windows 95. There was also a need to add an external CD-ROM drive to the LDS computer. Special instructions will be given to the librarian, on how to power down the computer and the CD-ROM drive, to avoid problems with the use of the machine.
- 4) The Obituaries have been loaded on the computer that used to be the LDS computer and that computer is now on the computer table with the other computers. We will soon need to upgrade this computer so that the database may grow. We predict that the obituaries file will grow quite rapidly and a larger hard drive would be the first improvement needed. Second would be the need for more RAM, which would speed up the program. Supposedly it is quite slow right now.

- 5) All 4 of the PRDH computers are now installed with an English version of PRDH.
- Fairfield's computer that she is using to do work at home for the society. She had to finally resort to bringing the computer to Joe, due to the unavailability of Roland or myself to help her fix the problems. We would like to see if it is possible to get her a more advanced computer to do her work on. These older computers that we get for the society are mostly castoffs and while they do the job quite well for the society, they are wearing out even before they come in. The society needs to supply its membership and volunteers with reliable tools to help in their research. This is just a suggestion and in no way is a request for an immediate purchase, just food for thought.
- 7) Other than the above things, I have heard of no other problems or fixes, and nothing seems to be broken as of this date. If that is an incorrect assumption, please notify either Roland or myself, via email, and we will attempt to fix the problem as soon as we can.

Revised Book/Archive Fund Guidelines

At the May meeting, we addressed and adopted part of a proposal to separate the Acquisitions Committee from the Library Board, and to allow the Acquisitions Committee to spend up to \$500 for any single item or collection without requiring Board approval. This message contains a revised and reworked set of the remaining provisions to address some concerns raised at the May meeting.

Book Fund

The Acqusitions Committee shall have sole responsibility and authority for expenditure of any monies contributed to the Book Fund for the purchase of resource materials, including, but not limited to, books, microfilms, microfiche, compact discs, serials, monographs, and periodicals. This policy shall not prevent other committees or departments from purchasing resource items with their own funds.

The Acquisitions Committee shall coordinate with other committees, such as the Library Board, who may seek expenditure of funds from the book fund for binding, preservation of library holdings, or archival efforts. Subject only to any bylaw provision to the contrary, the Book Fund shall be used solely for purchasing, leasing, binding, preserving, maintaining, storing, or restoring resource materials.

In an effort to avoid unnecessary duplication of items in the collection, the Acqusitions Committee shall coordinate efforts with other Society committees, including the Library Board, which shall have authority to review donated items, to see if an item has been donated before purchasing an item. Items purchased by the Acqusition Committee shall be included in the ACGS Library, and may not be screened or reviewed for inclusion in the ACGS collection.

The Acquisitions Committee has an obligation and responsibility to make prudent acquisitions and

expenditure of funds from the Book Fund. Consistent with this responsibility, the Acquisitions Committee shall be authorized to offer for sale, transfer, or exchange any item purchased by the Acquisitions Committee which needlessly duplicates any ACGS holding, provided one copy has been purchased by the Acquisitions Committee, and irrespective of whether the second copy was purchased by the Acquisitions Committee, some other Society committee, or donated to the Society. The Committee may offer the item for sale through a society event or communications medium, through an exchange with another society, transfer it to an ACGS chapter, or donate it to another society, depending upon the best disposition of that item in light of its resale or exchange value. The Acquisitions Committee shall not have any responsibility or authority to dispose of any duplicate items in which no copy of the item was acquired using Book Fund money.
