Sept. 17 through 19, 2002

President Craig Donais notified members electronically that "Lucie heard from Stephen White who inquired what our honorarium was, and she advised him that it was just upped to \$150 from \$125. He told her that when he came to ACGS in 1999, the sum was \$150 then, and he thought it would have gone up some since then."

"I know that we just discussed this issue on Thursday, but there seems to be a genuine concern that we may not be able to obtain high quality speakers for our events if we do not increase the fee. One thought we had to adequately compensate, yet not increase the base fee to offer a \$50 supplement for participation in a Friday or Sunday interactive program, just like we have this year on Friday. In years where there is no 'program' with speakers, our Saturday speakers could participate in the program on Friday (like the Soiree), but without additional compensation. "

"so, the motion is

TO PROVIDE A SUPPLEMENTAL HONORARIUM AT THE RATE OF AN ADDITIONAL 1/3 OF THE FULL HONORARIUM TO SPEAKERS WHO PARTICIPATE IN A FRIDAY OR SATURDAY PROGRAM. "

"This year the motion would affect Sylvie Tremblay and Stephen White, and would lead to an additional outlay of \$100."
