Hello all,

Regarding the sign:

1. I think the sooner we get the sign installed the better. As Julie stated it is vacation season and many people are out and about; so the more exposure we can get will be a definite plus. Earlier installation will also allow us to think about placement of a banner for our 30th and how we will go about accomplishing that.

2. As far as the angle is concerned, I think that 45 degrees would be too sharp an angle and would limit visibility from the southbound cars on Elm St. I think Larry's idea of the sign being parallel to Elm St. would enable it to be seen quite well from all directions. I believe the positioning should be as close to the corner as the set backs allow so as to maximize visibility from oncoming traffic in the Baker St. direction. It would also get the our sign out beyond the 'No parking here to corner' sign and not block visibility due to parked cars.
