Good Evening Gerry, I had Johnson Controls go through the heating system at our annual inspection and the gentleman said the system was in good shape. As far as pipes leaking that is inevitable given the age of the building, these things I check routinely as best I can. Since I took over the B&G I have the system gone through every year, Gerry I am a little surprised with the fact that Gerry L. is all of a sudden concerned about the system given the fact that he was B&G and between him and Marcel they for 6 to 8 years didn't have the system checked or maintained on a yearly maintenance schedule nor have the roof checked yearly ie. the water damage to the walls? I am a firm believer in you check and repair the roof yearly which protects the shell of the building and you maintain the the heating system which protects the integrity of the same. I have talked to Brian Untiet about fixing the water damage and he felt it would be cheaper for us to do it on a hourly basis and I agree with him, he said after the holidays he would come in when it was slow for him and do the repairs a little at a time. He also felt that he could help us with the pressure washing the building but given the time of the year we felt that spring time would be better. I will be meeting after the first of the year with the glass company to discuss the window situation. I have gone through the building with the plumbing outfit about estimating the plumbing repairs but that was before the hot water replacement issue came up so I will wait till January. Richard Untiet, the electrician is in the process of giving me a rough estimate on electrical issues. As far as the cleaning lady goes, I don't know if you are aware of a minor problem involving Mary Anna and the cleaning person and I, which I will discuss with you in person, but I did talk to Pauline the other night about it. I have talked to Kathy about this situation and she is in the process of training a new person and she has assured me that it will be addressed. Once I get the info together I will call you about the issues and probably attend the January meeting if that is okay with you. Brian will be removing the file cabinets and computor items and other items within the next couple of weeks, I will be home with my wife for the next few days as she will be having surgery concerning some back problems so if anything comes up or you have any other concerns please give me a call. I hope this answers your questions but as far as the heating system goes I feel we are in good shape, based on the feedback from Johnson Controls. Thanks Herb

#### · Electrical work.


I also noticed that there is a growing collection of cobwebs around the windows and stairwells. Is this something that our cleaning service can clean up? How about window washing? Who normally does that?
