The What's New page was accessed 752 times.


The 'Tree of Life' page got 297 hits.

Meeting held Monday, July 9, 2007.

Members present: Jim Gaudet, Constance Hebert, Pauly Labbe, Muriel

Normand, Mary Anna Paquette, Jackie Watson, and guest Roger Lanctot. Bob

Neveux was unable to attend.

1. NEGATIVE FILM READER/PRINTER: The Film Printer(#90) is now working, at least for the present. Some of the Board members were able to clean it up and replaced the cartridge which seems to have solved the problem. Since we are unable to obtain replacement parts, or get service for the machine, the Board of Directors still needs to consider getting it replaced. Since Bob Neveux was not at the meeting this morning, I will email him to get the name and phone number of the leasing company the City Library uses and forward it to the BoD.

2. DROUIN COUPON COUNT: There were 165 coupons turned in from May 5th to June 18th.

(running total = 1,415, if my calculations are not too far off that amounts to about \$7,000.+/- [using \$5/ticket])

- 3. BUCK-a-BOOK SALE: The sale of A-C Genealogist periodicals at \$1/book does not seem to be going very well. A question was raised about whether there is a searchable "Article Index" on the web site. I looked and couldn't find it. It would seem that if someone was looking for a particular article, in order to purchase the periodical, we should have some simple list of articles they can search.
- 4. GETTING VOLUNTEERS TO REMEMBER TO PUT AWAY FILM/FICHE AND BOOKS: Despite continual reminders in the volunteer bulletins, those items are still not always put away particularly on Sundays. The only solution is to keep reminding them.
- 5. PURCHASE OF ACQUISITIONS: The members of the Library Board would like to have input regarding the purchase of repertoires. There are a number of repertoires now published by the Northern NY Society which would be useful in the library. While we realize that our board meetings are not convenient for Larry, we hope that we can communicate effectively via

e-mail. I will be sending a message to Larry Autotte with a list of those books which we would like him to purchase (and will cc the BoD).

- 6. DROUIN TRAINING: A number of volunteers are still not familiar enough with using the Drouin collection to help searchers find their info and get it copied to CD's. There is a usage guide in the computer area, and a copy in the Librarians' Handbook (which, by the way, has been updated and is on the desk). Refresher training and review of the guidelines wil be stressed.
- 7. INSPECTION OF THE CHAIRLIFT: It appears that ACGS is late each year in getting the chairlift inspection done, thereby incurring late charges. The question arose about who exactly is accountable for making sure this is done each year in May when it is supposed to be completed. The consensus is that the Building/Grounds person, Herb Boyce at the present time, would be responsible for this. The question was also asked as to whether or not annual inspections can be automatically scheduled so that ACGS doesn't have to worry about it. We will leave it to the Board of Directors to communicate with Herb and see what can be arranged.

It was also noted that the 2006 inspection certificate is not on display. Does anyone know where it is? Did we ever receive it from the State of NH?

8. TURNING OFF A/Cs: The volunteers will be reminded, again, that they need to just turn the master switch in the electrical panel on/off. Also, one of the A/Cs is not working again - the same one on the right hand side. I left Herb a message about it this morning.
