Subject: Library Board Report

Meeting held Monday, Nov. 5, 2007 (There was no meeting in October)
Members present: Constance Hebert, Pauly Labbe, Muriel Normand and Mary Anna Paquette. Jackie Watson was unable to attend.

- 1. Drouin Coupon Count 10/1/2007 to 11/12/2007 = 112
- 2. More Space In an effort to find suitable wall space to hang the framed maps donated by Tom Bouffard, the following suggestions were made by the Board of Directors and concurred by the Library Committee/Board. Jim Gaudet has agreed to see what he can do about getting someone to move the heavy stuff.
- The big class cabinet now used for display of Repertoires for sale will be removed since it's function there is no longer useful. This should be moved down to the first floor to use for display.
- The large 5-drawer lateral cabinet will be moved upstairs.
- The glass bookcase housing the "Jesuit Relations" collection, and some other valuable books, needs to be moved to the area where the tall lateral is now.
- Still in discussion are the bookcases housing the ACA collection. IF we could get the Manchester City Directories on microfilm, that would give us a little more space on the back wall and the ACA books could be moved to that area.
- 3. Cleaning Party Since the people we hire to clean the library now have limited responsibilities (cleaning the bathrooms/kitchen, vacuuming the floors, and little else without charging us more \$\$), we are going to have "Volunteer Cleaning Party". This will be to: shampoo/clean the upholstered chairs, dust the bookshelves and cabinets, dust the desks and around the computers, dust the window ledges in the halls, vacuum the halls, perhaps wash all the windows on the inside. We will ask for volunteers and if anyone has an upholstery cleaning machine they can bring it in. Pizza/refreshments will be provided (I haven't yet asked the BoD to pay for this, hopefully there won't be any objection!)
- 4. Thermostat It gets very warm in the library when the heat is running. Some time ago Herb Boyce told me that the main thermostat is on the first floor and that controls the building. Since that is obviously the coldest area in the building, we are asking that the thermostat on the first floor be turned down a couple of degrees. This will accomplish two things: save a little \$\$ on heat, and keep the 2nd floor more comfortable!
- 5. Some Books Moved If you are on the Volunteer Librarian List, you have already received the

following info.

Moved books - the following collections of books have been moved to different shelves:

Drouin Microfilm Index, "Inventaire des 2365 microfilms du Fonds Drouin" (published by Pepin)

-> moved to bookshelf incomputer area

Fichier Histor, by Rene Jetté (published by Pepin)

[I think there are 35 or 36 volumes. These were laying on the edges which is not good for the binding.] -> moved to the bottom shelf of the case of reference books in the middle aisle, with room for expansion when we receive the rest of the alphabet (beneath the Jetté and Tanguay books)

Reference Books that were on the bottom shelf

-> moved to the bookcase on the left in the alcove where the "Fichier Histor" were originally stored.

Dictionaries that were on top of the "Family Files" lateral cabinet have been moved to the bookshelf near the office area.

Some of these books need to be re-numbered and labeled. Please bear with me, this will get done eventually!

- 6. Library Board Budget I have been asked to provide a budget for 2008. We really need some input on this.
