Overall, we continue to experience increased web site activity each year.

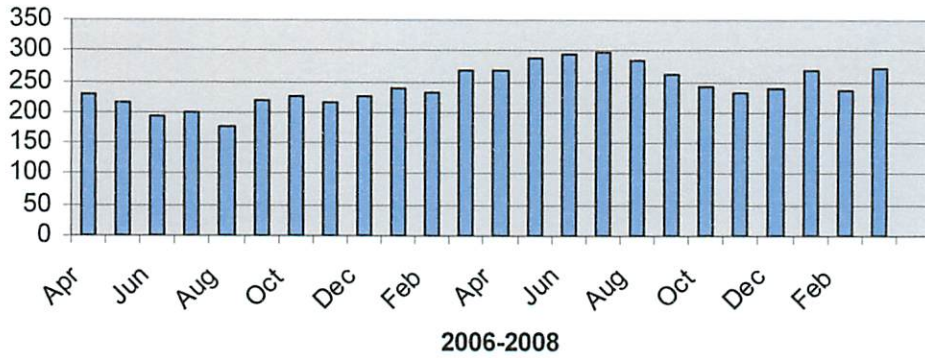
I have made some updates to the web site. BJ Shoja supplies us with an impressive list of activities which I've added to the events page.

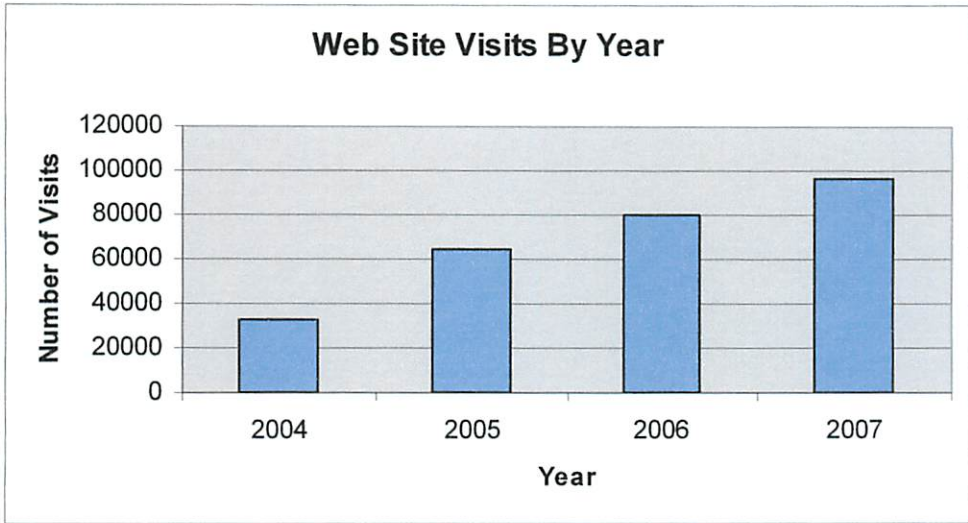

## MAILING & SHIPPING MARCH 2008

March was the busiest month this year. There were 23 individual pieces mailed – not counting a pending order to Canada, for a total of \$306.66 spent for mailing.

The breakdown was as follows:

Lorette and Pauline found the "missing" #s114 & 115 *A-C Genealogist's*. They were put in the mailing room, stored in copy paper boxes and secured. I had actually moved them into the supply room – believing that these were full boxes of copy paper that had been stored downstairs after delivery.

On an unrelated note, I did send a letter to my former home parish in Chicopee – Ste Rose de Lima, seeking the pastor's permission to publish their records. I have not back from him yet, and hope it was due to the Easter season and his vacation. This parish is a wealth of French-Canadian records, and to this day is a two priest and one deacon, active parish with its own cemetery and parochial school. Many of the Holyoke families end up here or down the hill in Willimansett at Nativity BVM (another church we should get).
