Subject: Web Site statistics for March, 2008

For March we had 8407 visitors to our site. That's 271 visits per day. Overall, increases were seen for the month of March. That pretty much agrees with the pattern from previous years.

Our holding lists were viewed 4,725 times.
Our catalogs were accessed 450 times.


Overall, we continue to experience increased web site activity each year.

I have made some updates to the web site. BJ Shoja supplies us with an impressive list of activities which I've added to the events page.



March was the busiest month this year. There were 23 individual pieces mailed – not counting a pending order to Canada, for a total of \$306.66 spent for mailing.
