## ACGS BOARD OF DIRECTORS MEETING April 10, 2017

MEETING CALLED TO ORDER: at 10:11 AM by President Bernadette Meunier

#### Review/Approval of January minutes:

Motion made by Constance Hebert and seconded by Cecile Durocher to accept March minutes as presented. Motion passed.

#### **REPORT OF OFFICERS:**

#### TREASURER'S REPORT:

The Treasurer's report was sent electronically to all members.

Ron reports that we are breaking even ytd. The \$8,000 received from the Dallas Library book sale will be deposited into the St. Mary's account as we would like to increase our presence at St. Mary's because they have been very supportive of the society.

We have a possible rental for upstairs. At \$9.15/square foot this would amount to about \$2,000/month, and would be a three-year contract. The group is waiting for a reply to their grant proposal. The contract would begin the third week of August for three years; the group would like the option to extend if grants are available.

The rooms would have to be made ready and arrangements made with the cleaning staff to maintain the third floor space.

We will need a new "no unauthorized parking" sign for the parking lot. The sign will be purchased and replaced by Herb.

Motion made by Jackie Watson and seconded by Constance Hebert to accept the Treasurer's report. Motion passed.

#### **CORRESPONDENCE:**

The Corresponding Secretary's report was sent electronically to all members.

#### **COMMITTEE REPORTS:**

#### **MEMBERSHIP:**

Membership report was sent electronically to all members.

It was noted that our membership numbers have fallen below 1200 for the first time.

#### **PUBLICATIONS:**

Constance has been updated as to ongoing projects and their status. We will need to clean up and finish with some of the older files before beginning any new projects. Jean-Baptiste in Keeseville, NY and a few other files from MA and NY are in progress and need to be completed.

1200 copies of the Genealogist were ordered; 128 came back to us. This seems to leave us with too many copies. We will need to consider cutting down the number printed as this is expensive. There was discussion as to who is responsible for sending out the digital Genealogist. This will be discussed with Gerry Savard.

#### **BUILDING/GROUNDS:**

The cameras in the building are set up and running. These will be monitored by Herb. The number of cameras can be expanded as needed. Herb would like to wire the system for wifi so he can have the capability to monitor our cameras from his phone. The cable needed was donated to the society. Board members approved of this idea.

The phone bill has increased by over \$200 per month because the deal we had with Fairpoint expired. Ron, along with Gerry and Chris, with look into getting a Comcast account for our internet service.

Bernadette would like some signs to be put up to give the society more presence in the building. Herb has purchased some signs and he will put them up.

Two new doors for third floor classrooms have been purchased and will be installed by Herb. The cost is about \$1.000, but these were needed for safety reasons.

#### **ACTION ITEMS/OLD BUSINESS:**

Updating of the library volunteers' manual is nearly completed. This updated manual will be given to Bernadette for review. When the manual is ready there will be a mandatory meeting for volunteers for retraining on certain procedures that have been a problem in recent months. Volunteers will be asked to sign a document stating that they have read the manual and understand the rules and procedures related to working at the front desk.

David Wilson has conducted an inventory of repertoires and has updated our database.

The library/research area will be renamed the Roger Lawrence and Lucille Caron-Legasse Research Center. Bernadette and Jeanne B. will see to the purchase of a sign for this area.

#### \_\_NEW BUSINESS:

Jackie Watson, as desk volunteer coordinator, has expressed some concerns regarding a long time member. This member was very active for some years before health issues forced him to cut back on his volunteer hours. At this time, Jackie purged cipher lock numbers that had not been used for two years. The member in question used someone else's number to get into the building when the library was closed. This person was told that he needs to volunteer at least three times per year in order to get a number and access to the library when it is closed. At this point the member stated that he had access to some of the codes and that he would use any number he wanted. Rather than remove him from the volunteer list as suggested by Jackie, this person will be given a second chance. He will be required to retrain and sign the new contract with other volunteers. Jackie will speak to him with Steve LeFoley as a witness. He will be sent a letter of reprimand and warned in writing that if this unauthorized use of cipher codes to enter building happens again, he will no longer be welcome as a volunteer.

A representative from the Franco American Center discussed the upcoming Poutine Fest with board members. He felt that this is an excellent opportunity to promote Franco American culture and to attract younger people into the Franco American community. He feels that it would be a good idea for members to dress in period costume to help build interest in French Canadian history and genealogy.

Times tickets will be sold for admittance at either 2:30 or 4PM. The admission price is \$30 for the Poutine Fest and the baseball game.

#### **ADJOURNMENT:**

Motion made by Jeanne Boisvert and seconded by Constance Hebert to adjourn meeting. Motion passed.

Attached are the above reports for your review prior to the April 9<sup>th</sup> Board Meeting. As you will note, our Year-to-Date Net Income is only \$24 vs. \$1,452 Last year. There are several reasons for this variance, one of which is the Building Expenses. You will recall that last year, the Parking Lot Rent was only paid for one month instead of three. That's a variance of \$1,400. Also, The Gas bill was not paid for one month, which is another \$850. We also had \$3,260 in Professional Expenses this year vs. None last year, for a variance of \$3,260. On the plus side, Membership Income rose \$1,300. This was not due to increases in membership, but to the more frequent posting of the checks as they came in. This is a one-time item, as next year will be comparable to this year. The other major revenue variance is the Building Fund. We are \$1,600 better than last year. This is due to three factors: 1.) we received a \$1,000 from Ms. Gravelle to purchase a Gold Leaf; 2.) we received memorial donations for the memory of Roger Lawrence; and 3.) we received memorial donations for the memory of Mr. Gravelle. Without these, our Building Fund Revenue would have been less than last year.

In reviewing the First Quarter 2017 Actual vs. Budget, we note the same one-time improvement in depositing of Membership Dues. Our Sales of Repertoires are \$300 under budget, however, I just deposited the Dallas Public Library check for \$8,279 on April 3rd. Again, the Building Fund is over Budget for the same reason as above. As for the Genealogist, Pauline threw me a curve ball. I budgeted for the Mailing and Publications Costs in the 2<sup>nd</sup>. Quarter. She decided to have it printed and mailed in March, so that they would be in members' hands by April 1st. I obviously had to prepay the postage, but paid the printing bill on April 1st, while still taking the 2% discount. She also ordered 1,200 printed and we now have 128 issues in over-stock. I told her to back off on the number printed, she acknowledged, but here we are. As for the Building Expenses, I only budgeted \$500 per month for Heat and it has been running at \$800 per month. I believe part of the reason is that the thermostats in the Publications Room and Treasurer's Office were on constant demand. Thus, we were pushing heat throughout the building for no reason. This has been fixed by Johnson Controls, and you will note that the building has cooled considerably on all three floors. We should get some savings during the next heating season to offset part of this. Electricity has increased over Budget. Cécile has been monitoring our usage and we have seen a spike in usage, which is most likely due to Girls at Work being more active with power tools. Unfortunately, our lease has a provision for increased rent, but, the electricity has to spike to 150% of normal before GAW came on the scene in order to re-visit the rent. We are running about 15% over normal.
